***Important:* The top five abstracts submitted by either undergraduate or graduate students will receive a \$500 stipend for accommodation and travel expenses to the NACRW 2018 conference. Registration fee will also be waived.**

Topics include but are not limited to:

- **Analytical Chemistry:** Liquid and Gas Chromatography, Mass Spectrometry, FT-IR, and UV-VIS techniques, advancements, and applications.
- **Separation and Purification Chemistry:** Sample preparation and extraction techniques.
- **Food and Contaminant Analysis:** Trace level analysis of pesticides, veterinary drug residues, toxins, heavy metals, unknowns, and other chemicals in food, animal feed, and environmental samples.
- **Microbiology:** New developments and analysis of food borne pathogens, MALDI-TOF Mass Spectrometry, PCR Mass Spectrometry and rapid testing.
- **Method Development and Validation:** Fitness for purposes, instrumentation for qualitative analysis, principal for quantitative analysis, confirmation, and optimization.

The meeting is expected to have over 400 attendees representing government, academia, and industries from all over the world.
